### WSQSA News

The new Racer building is progressing nicely. If everything goes well we will start having some work parties the first couple weeks of February to prep the track and finish details inside the building. Here are some of the latest Pictures.



A club meeting was held at Round Table Pizza to discuss some rule changes and the 2009 Season. The following was discussed and voted on:

Update Bylaws to remove Race Day Coordinator and replace with Public Relations Officer and change Article 6, Section 5 to read Annual membership shall run from the first race of the season and end at the first race of the following season. These changes were discussed and all changes to the bylaws were approved.

Change the GN season to include a Chase format like the Sportsman Class. Change was discussed and was approved. The GN class will run a Chase format for the 2009 season.

Set the remainder of the 2009 schedule. The first seven races were set last meeting and the remainder of the season was discussed and set. Listed in the 2009 Race Schedule is the entire season which will consist of 9 regular races and 6 Chase races.

## WSQSA News Cont.

Sportsman and GN will have 2 throw outs in the regular season and 1 throw out in the Chase. Bonus points will also be as follows:

3 points for showing up to race

1 point for winning main event

The bonus points accumulated are Chase Bonus points. The points will be accumulated during the regular season and added to your points at after the Chase points are awarded. There will not be any bonus points accumulated during the Chase.

**Rainout policy:** After topic discussion it was proposed that a rain out will not be rescheduled and will be called at the time off the drivers meeting. The club membership in attendance will vote on calling off the race. You will only receive bonus points if your show up to the track with car ready to race. If the race has started and it gets stopped for rain any classes that have been completed or at least completed 50% of the scheduled laps will be considered a completed race. Any class that has not completed at least 50% of their main event will show that race as a rain out and will not be rescheduled.

**Shorting a race from proposed distance:** After discussion it was proposed that shorting a race from its proposed distance, must be voted on before a race starts and must be a unanimous vote by the drivers in the class.

Class participation shall be per QSAC Rules. Member must declare which class they will be running and may only switch classes once per season. No driver may have a sub to fill in for them during the season.

Items of discussion for the next WSQSA Club Meeting:

We will discuss Entry fees and Sprint car rules. The next club meeting will be Saturday February 21<sup>st</sup>, 5:00pm at Round Table Pizza, Pasco.

## Tech Tidbit

If your shock spring collars rotate during a race changing your shock load can completely change your cars handling. To help prevent this you can do a couple things. If you use adjusters made of delrin you can crimp across the threads with side cutters, the second thing to do is to place an o-ring above the adjuster to place tension on adjuster.
