A club meeting was held at Round Table Pizza to discuss some rule changes and the 2009 Season. The following was dicussed and voted on:

The rule that the Season Championship winner from the Sportsman class must move up to GN was tabled and will be revisited before the end of the 2009 season.

The GN class will run the sportsman restrictor for club points races only with all other QSAC GN rules applying. Any National or invitational races will be run per QSAC rules.

The use of the CY intake blocks are NOT allowed. Only the QSAC approved intake blocks will be run.

The Chase format will continue for the Sportsman class. The first 7 races were discussed and voted on. See the Race Schedule section for the partial race schedule.

Our next event will be a Club meeting at 2:00pm January 17th at Round Table Pizza, Pasco. Topics will include Changing the GN class to a Chase format like the sportsman class. Review the Bonus/Show-up points (this will also clarify GN drivers driving for a sportsman driver in a non Chase race).
