Schedule update: The NW Nationals race at Cool Desert Nights has been firmed up, but the date has moved a week later. The race will be Saturday June 27th. The June 13th race has been changed to a parking lot race in Yakima and we are still waiting on confirmation of the July 4th exhibition race.

A club meeting was held at Round Table Pizza and the following was discussed and voted on:

Sprint Car rules were to be the main discussion, but due to the lack of Sprint drivers in attendance this discussion was tabled until the next meeting at the 1st race on March 21st.

It was requested that we put in a parking lot race in Yakima. After discussion it was voted to change the 6/13 race to a parking lot race in Yakima. It was stipulated that a location needs to be firmed up ASAP.

Next topic discussed was about a track that is located at Mary's Corner located on Highway 12 the other side of Packwood. The thought here was to try and organize a Fun day/weekend at this track inviting some drivers that have quarter scales on the coast and some 10th scale oval cars with the thought of trying to help establish interest in forming a Westside ¼ scale club, The track is built by a farmer on his property is big. If you go to Google earth and Google Mary's Corner Washington and move south you will see the track. This could be an excellent opportunity to expand ¼ scale racing in the Northwest.

Race Tech was the last item of discussion. Pre-Tech will be performed as follows. The track will close one hour before qualifying. Pre-tech will be performed in the in the first 30 min. after Track closes. The drivers meeting will be directly after which is 30 before qualifying. If your car did not get through tech prior to the drivers meeting you will not qualify and will start at the rear of the field.

Post-Tech will be performed as follows. At the end of the race the winner will pill draw after the race to determine if Tech will be performed. If Tech is to be performed then the winner will draw again to determine what will be Tech will be performed (like last year). The top 3 places will be go through Tech.

The track is a custom-designed, 1/10th mile, high-banked, indoor race track. The track is portable and fits inside the confines of a hockey rink. The lanes are about 15 feet and the corners are about 20 or more. The GLQSR boys were invited back and will talk about partisipation at the annual meeting. Tech Tidbit

If you damage your body in an accident and the body tears you can easily fix this by applying fiberglass drywall tape over the body tear and then spread Shoe Goo over the mesh. When this is dry the rip will be repaired and the body will still be flexible.
